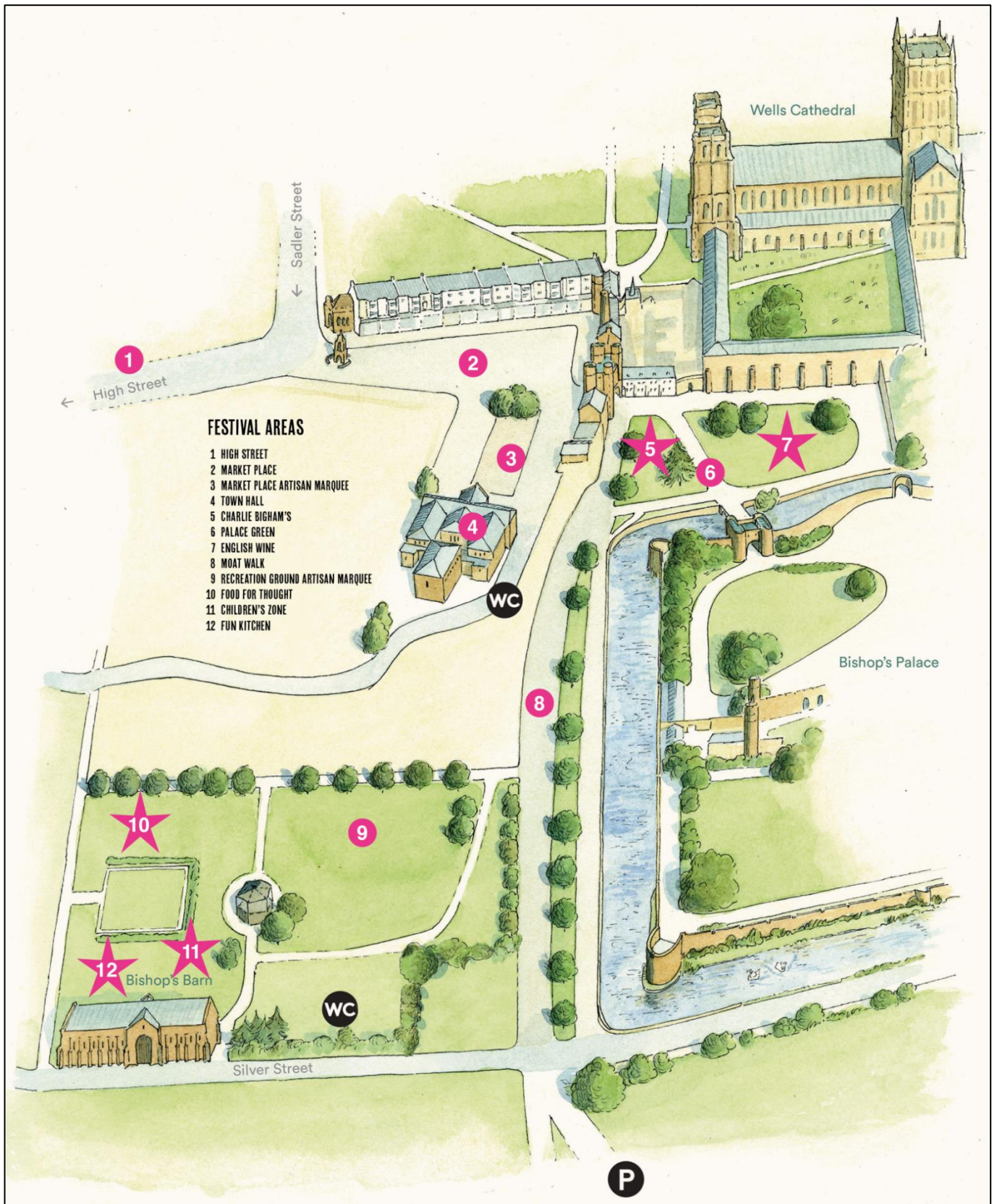

1 HIGH STREET

6 PALACE GREEN

10 FOOD FOR THOUGHT

The Food for Thought marquee returns to throw some light on how communities can tackle the challenges of current food-related social issues.

11 CHILDREN'S ZONE

Located next to the Bishop's Barn with a number of activities and stalls dedicated to our younger, budding foodie visitors. The popular Mogers Drewett interactive Children's Trail starts and finishes here.

12 FUN KITCHEN
